
Using your knowledge of the holiday, can you figure out the clues to this Hebrew Vocabulary Puzzle?

- 2. One of the Arba'ah Minim. Shaped like and symbolic of the spine.
- 4. Psalms 113-118 chanted or sung only on joyous occasions.
- 6. Intermediate days of the Festival (the third through sixth days of Sukkot)
- 8. The shade created by this must exceed the areas exposed to sunlight but one must be able to see through this to the stars at night.
- 11. Circle
- 12. One of the Arba'ah Minim. Shaped like and symbolic of the eye.
- 13. This is the name of a tractate in the Talmud as well as the name of this Festival.
- 14. One of the Arba'ah Minim. It represents those who have a knowledge of Torah AND perform good deeds.

Down

- 1. Three pilgrimage Festivals. On Pesach, Shavuot and Sukkot I sraelites journeyed on foot to Jerusalem.
- 3. One of the Arba'ah Minim. According to the Midrash it is shaped like and symbolic of the mouth.
- 5. Each day during Sukkot, we invite them join us in our Sukkah.
- 7. The "Four Species"
- 9. The Festival of Booths
- 10. Booth. Must be temporary.
